# REPORT ON A ONE DAY ENGAGEMENT WITH CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) VIRTUAL BUDGET REVIEW ENGAGEMENT WITH CSOs, HELD ON TUESDAY 19th MAY, 2020 AT THE DATA LAB, PLANNING AND BUDGET COMMISSION, VIA ZOOM VIRTUAL PLATFORM 

### 1.0 Opening

The meeting began at 10:30am with individual opening prayers followed by self-introduction.

### 2.0 Presentation:

The Director, Budget made a presentation on the draft 2020 Reviewed Budget which highlighted the processes and macro-economic assumptions underlying the review.

### 3.0 Observations and Questions raised:

At the end of his presentation, questions, comments and observations were raised thus:

1. In wew of the curent enbargo on rocuithent in the Skale one of the paricicants mas If the wew that there is neet I recrut mofe nealth montas being fiantine haalth

2. There is the nead for the CSOs to have the Excel document of the proposed reviened 2020 budget.

Responses were given to the issues raised above as follows:
i. The need to recruit more frontline health workers:

The State Government has reached an advanced stage in the process of recruiting more personnel in the health sector and will be concluded soon.
ii. Reduction of the Education budget by $50 \%$ and use of schools as makeshift markets:
a. It is only the Recurrent expenditure of the Education budget that was reduced by $50 \%$, as the schools have been closed since March 2020.
b. It is only the space within the schools that are being utilized as makeshift markets, not the physical structures. However, once the schools resume, the makeshift markets will cease to exist within the school premises.
iii. The need for CSOs to have the Excel document of the reviewed budget:

It was agreed that the Excel document of the reviewed 2020 budget will be made available to the CSOs in due course.

### 4.0 Challenges/Next Steps

The smooth flow of the virtual meeting was frequently interrupted due to network issues. It was then advised that participants should kindly forward any other observations, questions and comments they may have for further correspondence online.
